We are a preschool - 8th grade elementary school with an enrollment of 133 students, a school-wide Title 1 program with 10 highly qualified classroom teachers, 1.5 administrators (principal, counselor), Family Resource Center, and wonderful support staff. The school is very productive despite the challenge it faces of being a very small rural school with 82% free/reduced lunch eligible student population.
